

Laurel High School Mandatory Uniform Policy

2009-2010

Uniform dress is required to be worn by all students. All uniforms must be neat and clean. Violations to the dress code will result in school disciplinary action. The school uniform policy will accommodate students' religious expression.

COMPLIANT

Items listed below are in compliance with the uniform policy. The policy is for all students.

◆ Shirts- Polo

- WHITE only
- Long or short sleeved collared, polo-style shirt with TWO or THREE buttons at the neck.
- Cannot have piping embroidery, designs, logos, characters, names or numbers of any size **other** than the school logo or a Laurel athletic logo.
- Shirts must completely cover the midriff and not show any undergarments.

◆ Undershirts

- Must be white

◆ Other Shirts

- Team jerseys can be worn by athletes on game days only – Athletes who play on Saturday may wear the uniform on Friday.
- Seniors may wear their senior t-shirts the day before prom.
- Clubs participants, athletes and other activity participants may wear their “club” shirts on Friday.

◆ IDs must be CLEARLY VISIBLE at all times

- Must be worn around neck
- Temporary IDs must be worn on left chest.
- Students must have their **permanent ID** to purchase tickets and participate in school activities

◆ Belts (one color; solid black or solid brown)

- Leather, leather-like or braided belt must be worn through the loops and be buckled securely at the waist
- Belt buckles must be black, gold or silver toned.
- Cannot contain stripes, colors, insignia, characters, bottle caps, rhinestones, plastic, gel, eyelets, graphics, patches, inappropriate language, names, numbers or letters of any size.
- No LCD or graphic belt buckles.

◆ Shoes (SOLID BLACK in color)

- Black tennis shoes may be worn
- Stripe or insignia must be black
- Shoe laces must be black
- Shoes must be fully enclosed- no crocs, flip flops, sandals, slippers, or open toe or open heel shoes.
- Black boots may be worn – up to knees only and **MUST** be worn inside of the pant leg

◆ Pants

- Khaki colored chinos or dress pants
- Pants should not extend below the heel of the shoe
- Pants are to be worn securely around the waist with a belt through all the loops
- Cannot fall below the waist, be baggy or sag, and may not contain designer insignia, characters, names or numbers of any size
- Rubber bands, bandanas or add-ons are not allowed
- Pants cannot be rolled up or tucked into the shoes or boots.
- Pants cannot be altered in any way that changes the intended appearance (no cut pant leg)
- No form fitting/spandex, flared, cut/torn, jeans, cargo pants or any pants with any pockets on the leg.

◆ Skirts, Shorts and Skorts

- Khaki
- **Must hit the leg at the knee**
- No cargo shorts or shorts with pockets on the leg

◆ Socks

- Must be solid in color (White, Black, or Khaki)
- Must be absent of multi-color print, designs, cutouts, holes, characters, names, anything dangling or logos

◆ Outerwear

- Students may not wear any clothing over the white polo in the classroom setting.
- Students will be permitted to wear coats, sweaters, or outerwear between classes to the temporary buildings and in the hallway.

◆ Jewelry and accessories

- Necklaces must be worn inside the shirt.
- All jewelry and accessories must conform to the Prince George's County Public School student dress code policy.

◆ Field Trips

- Students must be in uniform, including wearing their permanent ID, when attending a field trip
- **Students not in uniform and/or not wearing their PERMANENT ID will not be permitted to attend field trips.**
