

POTOMAC HIGH SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY MANDATORY DRESS CODE (2007-2008 SY)

Potomac High School believes that a uniform policy provides a more secure environment, promotes an atmosphere for greater discipline, and increases learning opportunities for students by removing many of the distractions associated with various types of clothing.

All Potomac High School students are required to adhere to the uniform policy. New students will be given five (5) days from the date of enrollment to obtain the required uniform.

Uniform Fabric:

100% Khaki colored cotton/twill blend

No denim material

No blue jeans

No hip hugger pants

No corduroy

No sweatpants

No cargo pants (large, excessive side pockets, belts hooks and buckles)

Long Pants/Skirts/Skortis

Khaki-colored

Skirts/skortis must be worn knee length or extend below the knee and must be "fitted" around the waist.

Pants must be worn at the waist. Belts must be worn with clothing that has belt loops. Belts cannot be more than one size larger than the waist.

No oversized, baggy, sagging, too short or extremely tight fitting clothing.

Shirts

Navy blue, White (Long and/or short sleeves) with school logo—Long enough to be tucked in. Undergarments must not be visible. Clothing worn under shirts must be school colors (navy blue, or white)

Belts

Solid black with no design; must be sized to fit.

Shoes

Black completely black

Socks

No loud colors. If socks are visible, they can only be blue, black, and white.

Outerwear

In cold weather, inside the classrooms, students may wear navy blue, fleece jacket and a full zip or hoodless navy sweatshirt each with the wolverine logo. Any other outerwear is not permitted in the building.

All caps, hats, hoods, skull caps and bandannas are banned from school property, except when a medical condition applies or when covering is needed for weather conditions. No logos are permitted on headwear. Head covering may be worn outside the building only.
