Dear Parent/Guardian,

I am excited to announce that we will begin a new program at Walker Mill Middle School under the Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) framework. The program is titled the ***“Pathway to Success: Panther Pride Incentive Program.”***

The ***“Pathway to Success: Panther Pride Incentive Program,”*** is school-wide program that is designed to improve the overall academics and behavior of the school environment; therefore improving the success of all students. The purpose of the program is to promote positive success within the school environment and to reward students who do well both academically and behaviorally.

The Panther Pride Incentive Program focuses on five target behaviors for success. We expect our Panthers to be: **Prepared, Respectful, Intelligent, Dependable, and Excellent (PRIDE)**. Examples of what those positive behaviors look like are below.

As a part of the program, when students demonstrate the target behaviors, they are to be rewarded with “***Pride Points/Bus Bucks***” for doing so. (using the criteria above as a guide). ***Pride Points/Bus Bucks*** are tickets that resemble “money” and are given to students when they are “caught” exhibiting targeted behaviors. Students turn in the tickets at the appropriate venue in order to have a chance to win weekly prizes and/or the chance to attend incentives. Monthly rewards are given to classes that collect the most group “***Pride Points/Bus Bucks***.”

Students are expected to hold on to their ***Pride Points/Bus Bucks***. The reward for earning ***Pride Points/Bus Bucks*** will be weekly/monthly prizes and/or a chance to attend incentives. Information about incentives will be forthcoming.

It is my hope that we will all work together to ensure that the ***Panther Pride Incentive Program*** is successful. Parents/Guardians, please encourage your child(ren) to engage in positive behaviors and aim for success.
